IV. TREASURER REPORT:

July minutes

Revenues exceed expenditures for the month of July. The YTD deficit is down to \$70K due to the influx of property taxes

Miscellaneous income in the Police Fund was the reimbursement for the school resource officer. The \$20K capital outlay was for a patrol car.

In the MFT Fund the \$30K is for normal road repairs for this time of year.

In the Water Fund the capital outlay was for a new water line to some out-of-town customers. It was laid along an existing easement so there was no additional cost beyond the waterline itself.

Cash is still over \$1 million and the mortgage is \$600K.

Trustee Elliott made a motion to close Douglas St. from Main St to 3rd St on Friday, October 22, 2021, to host the trunk or treat. Trustee Richeson seconds. Roll call vote, all in favor, motion passed.
