September minutes

Salaries higher than usual in ordinance and finance because elected officials got those massive checks. The small amount of property tax revenue in the Police fund the cause of the deficit in the Police Fund. Misc. income is from reimbursement for SRO and tow releases. The capital outlay was the cost of moving equipment from an old police vehicle to our new one. Most of the \$300 in interest in the water Fund is bulk water sales. In the future, this revenue will be classified as water sales. The capital expenditures in the Water Fund are for the new water meters. The year-to-date deficit of almost \$115K in May is almost cleared up. The excess of cash over our mortgage is approximately \$1 million
